The meeting was called to order at 9 a.m. Central Time by Chairman Teupel. A quorum was declared.

Approval of Minutes

Motion by Mortenson, seconded by Heintz, to approve the minutes of the December 10, 2015, board meeting. All voted aye. Motion carried.

I. People

a. Board Election/Nominating – Connie Schroeder

i. 2016 Officer ballot and election

The report of the nominating committee was that Heintz was nominated as vice chair and Schroeder as secretary.

Motion by Mortenson, seconded by Gatzke, that nominations cease and a unanimous ballot be cast. All voted aye. Motion carried.

II. Growth



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- a. Historical news releases and History and Heritage Book Club Information was reviewed.
- b. Membership Promotion
The need to promote membership in the South Dakota State Historical Society and for South Dakota State Historical Society members to become Heritage Circle members was discussed. Lewis and Vogt are to discuss how to promote membership. The marketing committee is to meet before the next meeting to discuss membership promotion.
- c. Projects
 - i. 2016 Museum Requests
Vogt said that the museum will be changing the exhibit in the Hogen Gallery in November and the exhibit in the Observation Gallery in July. The museum is budgeting \$50,000 for the new exhibits in the galleries. A grant has been applied for from the South Dakota Community Foundation.
 - ii. Digitization
The Archives has \$20,000 from a Deadwood grant, Vogt said.
 - iii. History Conference
From \$5,000 to \$6,000 needs to be raised for the history conference, according Vogt.

III. SDSHS Presentation

Vogt said that the legislative session is going well for the South Dakota State Historical Society. The governor signed the Sully County land bill. Funding for the department is expected to remain level.

An individual is interested in developing a new curriculum for teaching South Dakota history to students. The person is looking for a fiscal agent.

Thanks to Gatzke, there has been communication with a family that has materials about Laura Ingalls Wilder.

Vogt summarized activities in each of the SDSHS's departments. Archaeology has been able to work in the field because of the open winter.

Archives has on display the only known letter signed by Hugh Glass. Archives has entered into a conversation with the attorney who handled the Mickelson airplane crash lawsuit.

Historic preservation is fighting the Veteran Administration's efforts to close the VA Hospital in Hot Springs.

The museum will be opening new exhibits in July and November.

Research and publishing is finishing the biography of Hugh Glass and is also working on a biography of Spotted Tail. The Press is looking at a series of Laura Ingalls Wilder books. The Press will be hosting the history conference in 2017 and is considering having the conference in Sioux Falls.

IV. Financials

- a. Treasurer's Report – Brian Gatzke
 - i. Financial reports
Financial reports were reviewed.



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Motion by Mortenson, seconded by Schroeder, to approve the foundation's fourth quarter 2015 financial reports and the Heritage Store's fourth quarter 2015 financial reports. All voted aye. Motion carried.

ii. 2016 budget approval

Motion by Mortenson, seconded by Gatzke, to approve the 2016 budget as presented. All voted aye. Motion carried.

iii. Foundation insurance

Lewis presented quotes from two insurance agencies for Directors and Officers Insurance and Employment Practice Liability Insurance.

Motion by Mortenson, seconded by Heintz to approve ordering Directors and Officers Insurance and Employment Practice Liability through Fischer Rounds & Associates. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Heintz recommended that Lewis check with Fischer Rounds about the cost of doubling the limit from \$1 million to \$2 million.

iv. Audit Plan – May 2016

The board had previously approved having an audit for 2015. The board reviewed a letter from John Clausen, a certified public accountant, about the cost of an audit and when the audit would be performed.

v. Administrative fee structure

A proposed administrative fee structure for the South Dakota State Historical Society was presented by Lewis.

Motion by Mortenson, seconded by Gatzke, to direct Lewis to prepare a proposal with input from Vogt and send it to board members as soon as possible. All voted aye. Motion carried.

a. Finance Committee Report

i. Investments Update – Richard Lauer

Lewis said that Lauer will have a report later.

ii. Pioneer Girl Investment Plan

Lewis said that Lauer is operating under the current policy.

Teupel said that once the first quarter report has been received from Lauer, the finance committee should review it.
